



COVID-19 Conditions of Use Indoor Facility Rentals

These conditions are in addition to those listed within the Facility Rental Contract. The rental agreement holder is required to share all conditions of use with all participants.

Groups are responsible for following established health and safety protocols, including provincial guidelines, guidelines established by the Municipality of West Perth and, if applicable, their association's governing body.

Vaccine Mandate

As of **Wednesday, September 22, 2021**, under Provincial Section 22 orders under the Health Protection and Promotion Act, patrons must have proof of full vaccination status to enter indoor facilities owned and operated by the Municipality of West Perth. Proof of vaccination (as seen below) must be issued through the Ontario Ministry of Health and presented alongside a valid piece of ID. As of **January 4, 2022**, only an enhanced vaccine certificate with QR code will be accepted to access these indoor facilities. Vaccine receipts without a QR code will no longer be accepted as valid proof of vaccination. You will need to continue to show a piece of identification with your name and date of birth along with your proof of vaccination when visiting

Exemptions:

- Children under 12 years of age.
- Patrons with a written document by a physician or nurse practitioner, stating that they are exempt for a medical reason from being fully vaccinated against COVID-19 and the effective time period.

Health Screening

Please have all participants and spectators of your rental complete an approved active screening before entering any Municipality of West Perth facility. Please see an example of active screening questions below:

1. Do you have any of the following new or worsening symptoms:
 - a. Fever (= or > 37.8C) / chills
 - b. Cough
 - c. Difficulty breathing / shortness of breath
 - d. Sore throat, trouble swallowing
 - e. Runny nose (unrelated to allergies)
 - f. Loss of taste or smell
 - g. Not feeling well, headache, unexplained tiredness & muscle aches
 - h. Nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, abdominal pains
2. Has a doctor, health care provider, or public health unit told you that you should currently be isolating (staying at home)?
3. Have you been identified as a “close contact” of someone who currently had COVID-19 in the last 14 days?
4. Have you received a COVID Alert exposure notification on your cell phone in the last 14 days (and have not been tested or waiting for your result)?
5. Have you or anyone you live with travelled outside Canada in the last 14 days?
6. Is anyone you live with currently experiencing any new COVID-19 symptoms and/or waiting for test results after experiencing symptoms?

If you answered YES to any of the above questions, PLEASE DO NOT enter this location AND contact your health care provider.

Personal Hygiene

Participants should practice proper hand hygiene techniques often. All patrons will be expected to use the hand sanitizer stations located around the facility.

Gathering Limits

Facility and room capacities listed below must be followed:

Physical distancing guidelines must be followed whenever possible.

Attendance

A record of attendance (names and contact information) must be taken for all members of your party, including volunteers, entertainment, caterers, etc. This information must be kept for at least one month and available to the Municipality of West Perth in the event of an outbreak.

Arrival and Departure

Please follow all signage posted outside and inside the facility. **Anyone entering the facility is required to wear a face covering.** Face coverings are mandatory when standing or moving throughout the facility and are strongly encouraged while seated and not eating or drinking.

Please follow all signage posted inside and outside of the facility. Patrons are asked to arrive no more than 10 minutes before their scheduled rental and to leave within 10 minutes of the conclusion of their rental. Facility access will be granted by a Municipality of West Perth employee.

Regardless of which room you are renting, all patrons should enter the facility through the main arena doors off the parking lot.

Amenities

All guests must be seated while eating and drinking. No beverage service will be available at this time, until further notice.

People renting the Activity Room should refrain from entering the lobby and instead use the private washrooms available within the room.
