



## COVID-19 Conditions of Use Indoor Facility Rentals

These conditions are in addition to those listed within the Facility Rental Contract. The rental agreement holder is required to share all conditions of use with all attendees.

Groups are responsible for following established health and safety protocols, including physical distancing guidelines, guidelines established by the Municipality of West Perth and, if applicable, their association's governing body.

### Health Screening

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The following must be true for any patron entering West Perth facilities:

1. I am not experiencing any symptom of illness such as cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fever, chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, or new loss of taste or smell.
2. I have not travelled to a highly impacted area in the last 14 days.
3. I do not believe I have been exposed to someone with a suspected and/or confirmed case of COVID-19.
4. I have not been diagnosed with COVID-19 and not yet cleared as non-contagious by local public health authorities.
5. I am following recommended health guidelines as much as possible to limit my exposure to COVID-19.

### Gathering Limits

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Facility and room capacities listed below must be followed at all times:

Physical distancing guidelines must be followed whenever possible. Face coverings should be worn when physical distancing is not an option.

## Attendance

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Organizations hosting events at West Perth facilities must do so by pre-registration and/or ticket sales. Tickets cannot be available at the door.

A record of attendance (including volunteers, entertainment, caterers, etc.) must be taken. This information must be available to the Municipality of West Perth in the event of an outbreak.

## Arrival and Departure

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Please follow all signage posted inside and outside of the facility. Patrons are asked to arrive no more than 10 minutes before their scheduled rental and to leave within 10 minutes of the conclusion of their rental. Facility access will be granted by a Municipality of West Perth employee.

All patrons entering the West Perth Community Centre will be required to wear face coverings whenever moving throughout the facility, outside of the specific room reserved for their recreational program or private rental.

### West Perth Community Centre Rentals

If you are renting the hall, please enter and exit the facility through the Community Centre doors off Wellington St.

If you are renting the Activity Room, please enter and exit the facility through the main Lobby doors off the parking lot. People renting the Activity Room should refrain from entering the lobby and instead use the private washrooms available within the room.
