



COVID-19 Conditions of Use Outdoor Facility Rentals

These conditions are in addition to those listed within the Facility Rental Contract. The rental agreement holder is required to share all conditions of use with all attendees.

Groups are responsible for following established health and safety protocols, including physical distancing guidelines, guidelines established by the Municipality of West Perth and, if applicable, their association's governing body.

Health Screening

The following must be true for any patron using West Perth facilities:

1. I am not experiencing any symptom of illness such as cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fever, chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, or new loss of taste or smell.
2. I have not travelled to a highly impacted area in the last 14 days.
3. I do not believe I have been exposed to someone with a suspected and/or confirmed case of COVID-19.
4. I have not been diagnosed with COVID-19 and not yet cleared as non-contagious by local public health authorities.
5. I am following recommended health guidelines as much as possible to limit my exposure to COVID-19.

Gathering Limits

Capacity at the Lions Pavilion cannot exceed a maximum capacity of 30 people.

Physical distancing guidelines must be followed whenever possible. Face coverings should be worn when physical distancing is not an option.

Attendance

A record of attendance must be taken and kept for two weeks following each rental. This information must be available to the Municipality of West Perth in the event of an outbreak.
