Crossing Guards

Part-Time/On-Call/Casual

Reporting to the Clerk, Crossing Guards are responsible for the safe passage of pedestrians (especially students/children) at their respective crossing, stopping traffic in accordance with the Ontario Highway Traffic Act, the Occupational Health and Safety Act and the Municipality of West Perth guidelines. Applicants must be available to fill in for morning and dismissal shifts during the school year, as required. The Crossing Guards must possess strong communication skills to effectively inform students and adults of crossing rules, as well as other information.

School Crossing Guards work during the school year (September - June, excludes holidays and PA days). Working part-time or on an on-call/casual basis shifts are approximately one hour in length during morning and afternoon school bell times.
