



Follow these steps to make payments by mail:



1. Attach your payment stub and make your cheque payable to the Municipality of West Perth.

Budget Process

West Perth prepares a budget each year with input from the Senior Leadership Team with final approval from Council and the Mayor. This process allows council and staff to prioritize asset improvements, capital expenditures, operating costs, and more.

2026 Election

Elections for municipal government are held every four years on the fourth Monday of October for a four year term. The next term will run from 2026-2030 with the election being held Monday, October 26th, 2026.

Members of Council:

- Represent the interests of residents and the municipality of West Perth;
- Participate in decision-making regarding municipal policies, programs, and services;
- Attend and contribute to council meetings and committees as required;
- Work collaboratively with other council members and staff to ensure the municipality operates effectively and efficiently.

Candidacy

Eligible candidates for municipal elections must:

- Be a resident of West Perth or a non-resident owner, or tenant of land in West Perth, or the spouse of such non-resident owner or tenant;
- Be a Canadian citizen and at least eighteen years old;
- Be eligible to vote and not disqualified by any legislation from holding municipal office;
- Complete a nomination form, pay a filing fee of \$100 (\$200 for Mayor) and collect 25 signatures.







Clerks Department

Responsibilities

The Municipal Clerk's department is responsible for managing the Municipality's records, administering elections, and providing information to the public.

Our responsibilities cover the following:

- **Record keeping:** Maintain official records, including by-laws, minutes, and agreements.
- **Elections:** Conduct municipal and school board elections.
- **Council support:** Serve as a secretariat for council and its committees, and provide administrative support to council members.
- **Information:** Provide information to the public, including access to municipal records.
- **Licences and permits:** Issue licences and permits, such as marriage licences, burial permits, and business licences.
- **Policy and Protocol:** Provide leadership in matters of policy, legislation and protocol.
- **Statutory duties:** Perform statutory duties under the Ontario Municipal Act, Planning Act, and other related statutes.

How We Support Our Community

Freedom of Information

Through the Municipal Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (MFIPPA), residents have the right to access municipal records with certain limitations and exemptions.

Licence Applications are required for:

- Marriages
- Refreshment vehicles (food trucks, ice-cream carts, hotdog carts and food trailers)
- Lotteries

Permits are required for:

- Sidewalk Patios
- Sidewalk Merchandise Displays
- Signs
- Special Occasions
- Event Tents
- Open Air Burning

Commissioner of Oaths

The Commissioner of Oaths will witness the signatures of people who are affirming/swearing the contents of a document to be true.

BOOK AN APPOINTMENT

These services are available in-person at the Municipal Office during regular business hours. Photo identification is required. We recommend booking an appointment to ensure a Commissioner of Oaths is available.

West Perth does not have a Notary Public on staff. For notary services, please contact a lawyer or public notary.

Budget & Finances

Responsibilities

The Finance Department is responsible for managing the financial affairs of the Municipality to ensure fiscal accountability, transparency, and sustainability.

This includes:

- Preparing and overseeing the annual budget and long-term planning
- Managing revenues and expenditures
- Administering property taxation and assessment
- Processing payroll and accounts payable/receivable
- Maintaining accurate financial records
- Ensuring compliance with legislative and regulatory requirements
- Asset management

How We Support Our Community

Budget

A budget is prepared each year with input from the Senior Leadership team with final approval from Council and the Mayor. This process allows council and staff to prioritize asset improvements, capital expenditures, operating costs, and more. The Municipal budget reflects the **services** you receive, the **infrastructure** used by the community, and **supports** provided to residents of West Perth.

Taxes

Property Tax, Streetlight, BIA Area Rate are applicable to West Perth residents.

Final Tax Installment Due Dates

- August 29, 2025 and November 28, 2025

By-Law Enforcement

Responsibilities

By-law Enforcement is responsible for enforcing Municipal By-laws to ensure a safe, quiet and enjoyable community for all residents. We act as a resource for residents for any questions or concerns relating to By-laws or other enforcement issues.

By-Laws in West Perth

West Perth's By-Law Enforcement Officer investigates the following:

- Noise and nuisance complaints
- Littering and dumping
- Property standards issues
- Parking

To report the following Animal Related Issues:

- **Lost/Found dogs:** Contact the Stratford Perth Humane Society at 519-273-6600
- **Noise complaint (barking dogs):** West Perth By-Law Enforcement at 519-348-8429 x 215
- **Dead animal on a Municipal road/property:** West Perth Operations Department

Reporting By-Law Violations

Steps for reporting a by-law violation:

1. Report the violation via the By-Law Infraction Form or by contacting the By-Law Enforcement Officer.
2. Provide your name, address and contact information.
3. Provide details of the concern.
4. The By-Law Enforcement Officer will investigate the reported issue.
5. A courtesy warning is often issued on a first offence depending on the infraction. Subsequent or continued violations may result in fines or court proceedings.



Parking By-Laws in West Perth

- No parking on residential streets between 2:00 - 6:00 a.m. from November 1st - March 31st.
- No parking on/obstructing sidewalks
- Downtown parking is limited to three hours during the hours of 9:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m.
- Parking in Municipal Lots (no overnight parking during winter) for these locations: Montreal Street, Keterson Park, Centennial Park/Visitor Centre, West Perth Municipal Building-front/back lots
- Winter overnight parking passes are available for landlords and tenants who live in the downtown area and do not have access to designated parking spaces. Passes can be requested by contacting the Municipal Office and are valid from November 1st to March 31st.

Building, Planning & Renovating Services

CloudPermit On-Line Application Process

CloudPermit is an online system to manage applications for building permits to streamline the permit, manage inspection requests and reduce our carbon footprint.



Apply for and monitor the status of your building permit(s) online, anytime and from anywhere.

Responsibilities

The Building Department's role is to review, issue, and inspect building permits to ensure that structures are safe, accessible, and comply with the Ontario Building Code.

How We Support Our Community

Building Permits and Building Applications

Formal permission from the Municipality of West Perth to begin construction or work to structures.

Building Permits are required for:

- New buildings or structures (residential, commercial or industrial)
- Any work done to existing buildings including any additions i.e. sun room, garage or porch
- Swimming pools
- Decks
- Signs
- Alter most buildings and structures on your property
- Sheds over 161 sq ft (e.g. 10ft x 16ft)
- Buildings with plumbing and/or heating
- Driveways
- Septic systems
- Installation of solar panels or green roof
- Installation of a chimney or fireplace
- Modifications to heating and plumbing systems
- Installation of backwater valves or backflow prevention devices
- Altering a building's use i.e. from single dwelling to multi-dwelling unit

Building Inspections

Building inspections are required for permit holders. They should be requested 24-48 hours prior to inspection, allowing the Municipality time to schedule the inspections.

Inspection Process

Permit holders are responsible for contacting the Municipality to schedule inspection when the construction is at the inspection stage set out in the building code.

Fire Department

How We Serve Our Community

Emergency Response

We offer 24-7 services and respond to:

- Structure fires
- Vehicle accidents
- Hazardous spills
- Carbon Monoxide Emergencies

Green Light Awareness

A flashing green light on a vehicle indicates that a volunteer firefighter is on their way to an emergency or to the fire station. When you are driving and see a vehicle with a green light, you should pull over to allow the firefighter to pass. This helps ensure they can reach the emergency or fire station as quickly and safely as possible.

Open Air Burning

A burn permit is required for all open air burning within the Municipality.



Fire Inspections

The West Perth Fire Department provides fire inspections and file search services for homes and other buildings (office buildings, event venues, etc.) to ensure you're complying with the Ontario Fire Code to prevent injuries and save structures.

Scheduling an Inspection

To schedule a fire inspection, residents can call the West Perth Fire Department at 519-595-2800 ext. 233 or email FPO@pertheast.ca.

Common Fire Code Violations

Fire code violations commonly observed during inspections typically involve safety, accessibility, and the proper operation of fire protection systems. Common violations often seen are:

- Blocked or obstructed exits, such as doors, stairways, or hallways, which can prevent safe evacuation in an emergency.
- Improper use of extension cords. These cords should only be used temporarily.
- Absence of smoke and carbon monoxide alarms. Your home should have working alarms on every level and outside all sleeping areas to maintain safety.

Emergency Services

Responsibilities

Perth County's Emergency Management program is a unified program for the County, and the Lower-Tier member municipalities of West Perth, Perth East, Perth South, and North Perth.

How We Serve Our Community

Perth County Paramedic Services

Perth County Paramedic Services is operated by Perth County and includes ambulance services for all municipalities in the County. Paramedics are dispatched by the Ministry of Health and Long Term Care Central Ambulance Communications Centre in London.

The Ontario Provincial Police (OPP)

The OPP provides police services for the County of Perth. The OPP deals with all law enforcement issues and criminal matters.

Emergency Preparedness Week

An annual national awareness initiative that occurs every May to take action and ensure residents are prepared to protect themselves, their family and their community during an emergency.

Cemeteries

Responsibilities

West Perth is dedicated to assisting families and individuals to understand and make decisions regarding cemetery services, and products.

Environment and Sustainability

Responsibilities

West Perth is committed to promoting energy conservation alongside responsible and sustainable waste management in our community.

How We Serve Our Community

Green Initiatives

West Perth promotes environment and sustainability through the following green initiatives:

- Tree planting programs
- Green spaces
- Electric vehicle (EV) charging stations
- E-Waste disposal

Environmental Preservation

In 2021, West Perth launched the West Perth Healthy Forests Grant, a financial incentive program for West Perth landowners to plant trees to improve ecosystem resiliency, carbon sequestration, and agricultural land preservation. The incentive offers eligible applicants a subsidy to offset the cost of trees by up to 30%.

Energy Conservation

West Perth owns and operates one free-standing, forty panel, ten-kilowatt solar photovoltaic system located at the Wastewater Treatment Centre in Mitchell. In 2023, the system produced 10,190 kWh of energy.

A solar heating system at Lions Pool in Mitchell is a rooftop heating system which exclusively warms the pool water. There is no metering on this passive solar water heater, and therefore cannot be quantified.

Proposed locations for additional solar arrays include:

- The West Perth Municipal Office
- The Fire Hall
- Keterson Park Pavilion

All three of these buildings were engineered with the intention of incorporating solar arrays in capacity as part of our commitment to net zero by 2050.

A partnership program between West Perth and the Upper Thames River Conservation Authority that provides affordable, native hardwood trees to residents to create a greener and more beautiful community.

Mitchell Dam and Reservoir

The Upper Thames River Conservation Authority (UTRCA) is responsible for the operation and maintenance of the dam. The UTRCA contracts the Municipality of West Perth to undertake routine operation and maintenance of the dam based on protocols and direction provided by the UTRCA.



Routine Monitoring of the Dam

WINTER

The reservoir is kept low during the winter months to permit the North Thames River to freely pass through the structure and ensure ice does not damage the dam or gates. The reservoir remains at its winter levels through the spring thaw to ensure the dam has the capacity to safely discharge snowmelt and spring rains.

SPRING/SUMMER

The reservoir is typically filled near the end of April depending on weather conditions. When the reservoir is at its summer level, rain events that result in high flows in the North Thames River may require Municipal staff to operate the dam gates based on protocols established by UTRCA, to permit floodwaters to pass through the structure without causing damage.

From mid-spring to mid-fall, the community can use the area north of the dam for leisure water sports such as paddleboarding, kayaking and canoeing.

FALL

The reservoir water is released in early November drawing the reservoir back down to its winter level.

LET'S GET GRILLING

- For propane and gas grills, check the tank and valves for leaks before using it.
- Keep your grill clean by removing grease or fat build up from the grills and in trays below the grills.
- Place the grill well away from the home, deck railings, and out from under the eaves and overhanging branches.
- Always make sure your gas grill lid is open before lighting it.
- Keep children and pets at least one meter away from the grilling area.
- If you use starter fluid when charcoal grilling, only use charcoal starter fluid. Never add charcoal fluid or any other flammable liquids to the fire. When you are finished grilling, let the coals cool completely before disposing in a metal container.
- Never leave your grill unattended when in use.

Melted snow, budding trees, longer days: they're all signs that the warmer months are nearing. For many of us, these seasonal hallmarks are reminders to start spring cleaning in and around our homes.

As people power up their lawnmowers, rake up debris, touch up chipped paint, and take on multiple projects to get their homes and yards ready for the months ahead, keep in mind some of these best practices to minimize the risk of fires.

Properly use and store gasoline

- Use gasoline only as motor fuel, never as a cleaner or to break down grease.
- Only store gasoline in a container approved for that purpose and never bring it indoors, even in small amounts. Keep it in a detached garage or outdoor shed.
- Make sure the container is tightly capped when not in use.

Use/store flammable and combustible liquids with care

- Flammable and combustible liquids should not be used near an open flame.
- Never smoke when working with these liquids.
- If you spill liquids on your clothing, remove your clothing and place it outside to dry.
- Keep liquids in their original containers. Keep them tightly capped or sealed. Never store the liquids in glass containers.

Clean out your clothes dryer

- Make sure the air exhaust vent pipe for your dryer is not restricted and that the outdoor vent flap will open when the dryer is operating.
- Inspect the vent piping with a flash light for signs of excess lint build-up. Have them cleaned out if necessary.
- Move things that can burn, such as boxes, cleaning supplies and clothing, away from the dryer.



West Perth Operations staff routinely complete road, sidewalk and bridge inspections to create a maintenance schedule for the necessary repairs. Maintenance activities include patrolling the roads for potholes, shoulder drop-offs, cracks, signage repairs and winter control standards.

West Perth aims to complete one infrastructure reconstruction project per year, considering both short- and long-term growth.

Snow Removal

West Perth is committed to providing a high level of snow removal service throughout the winter season.

Primary, secondary, and residential roads are defined by Minimum Maintenance Standards for Municipal Highways.

Sidewalks

Public works staff are responsible for snow removal of sidewalks in Mitchell, including:

- All blocks north and south
- All connecting links highways (Huron, Ontario, St. George and Blanshard)
- East to West blocks on Frances Street East, Henry St. (St. Andrew to Arthur Street North)
- Campbell Street (Wimpole to Napier) and William Street (Wimple to Napier)

Sidewalks are cleared after snow accumulation reaches 8 cm generally within twenty-four hours after the end of the storm; however, when we have a heavy snowfall or successive winter events back to back this may take longer.

Extreme Weather Events

In the event of extreme weather in the winter season, the Municipality may choose to declare a Significant Weather Event. Declaring this extends the timelines in which the Municipality is given to complete winter operations.

Hazardous and Special Waste (MHSW) Depot

The landfill will accept the following as hazardous waste:

- Paints, varnish, solvents, caulking, glue
- Fuels, antifreeze, brake fluid, used motoroil and filters
- Batteries (household, rechargeable, automotive)
- Household cleaners, light bulbs, beauty Products

Leaf and Yard Waste

A bagged leaf collection service is provided to Mitchell Ward residents from mid-October to mid-November each year.

For your leaves to be collected, follow these guidelines:

- Only leaf material is acceptable and must be in a paper bag.
- Bags must not exceed 25 kgs (50 lbs).
- Ensure leaf bags are placed on boulevard, clear of any obstructions (examples: trees or parked vehicles).

Water & Wastewater

Drinking Water

West Perth is committed to providing a safe, consistent drinking water supply while maintaining strict adherence to all applicable legislative and regulatory requirements.

Water Readings

West Perth completes water meter readings each month and residents are billed on a bi-monthly cycle.

Water Leaks

Common causes are leaky toilets, dripping faucets, leaky hose bibbs and malfunctioning water softeners.

Water Testing

In compliance with Ontario Regulation 170/03, West Perth monitors the water weekly with the following tests:

- Weekly raw and treated water sampling.
- Daily chlorine residual monitoring.
- Testing for microbiological contaminants including THMs, HAAs, lead, nitrates, pesticides, and other substances.

Private Well Water Testing

Huron Perth Public Health offers free bacterial water testing for private wells. Test at least three times a year, in spring, summer, and fall. Pick up sample bottles at the West Perth Municipal Office, submit within 48 hours of collection. Contact the Health Unit at 1-888-221-2133.

Waste Water Treatment Plant & Collection Systems

Storm sewers collect rain and melted snow to prevent flooding, directing the water to storm ponds or the Thames River. They are not for disposing of automotive fluids or cooking grease - take hazardous waste to the landfill depot.


